Alex: It was introduced at the end of the 4th century by the Christian Church until Good Friday before Easter.

Lenka: Carnival celebrations vary regionally, in every town and village there are different celebrations.

Sara: Carnival is the period of balls, dances and parades. People wear scary and animal-like masks and costumes. Despite the fact that people celebrate a lot, they also eat a lot.

Meggie: They eat a lot of delicious food and lots of donuts filled with jam. Children like wearing funny costumes, paint their faces, have Carnival parties at school. Folk music and dances are popular during this season.

Radovan: The traditional Carnival celebration is burrying a contrabass or burning Morena (an effigy of witch made of straw in a woman's dress) and throwing it into a river.

Nikol: One aspect of a Carnival season (Shrovetide) was dedicated to honoring deceased. Antient pagans wore masks to remember their connections with their past.

We have to keep our traditions, because they belong to our history and we should know about them as much as possible.
